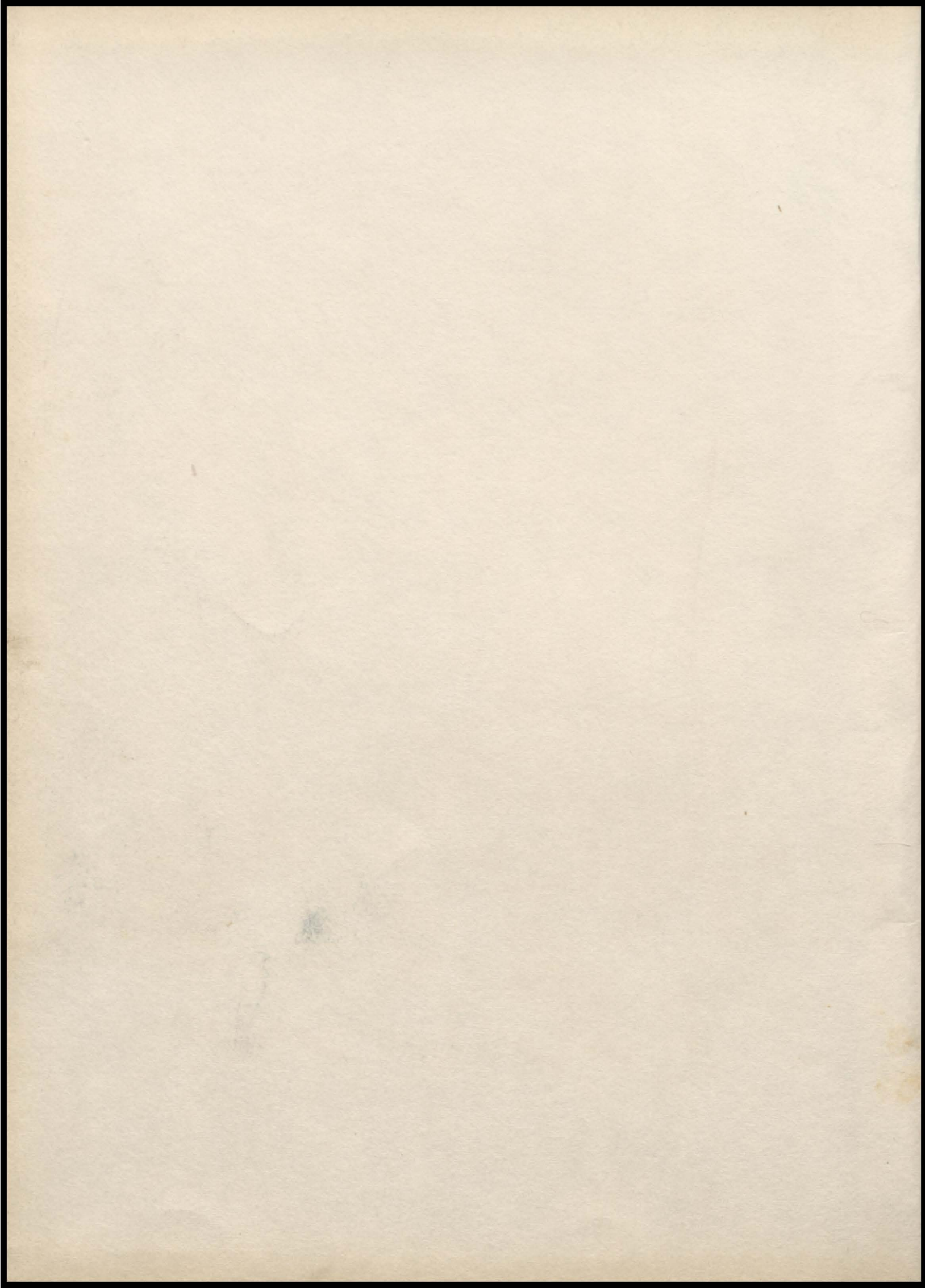


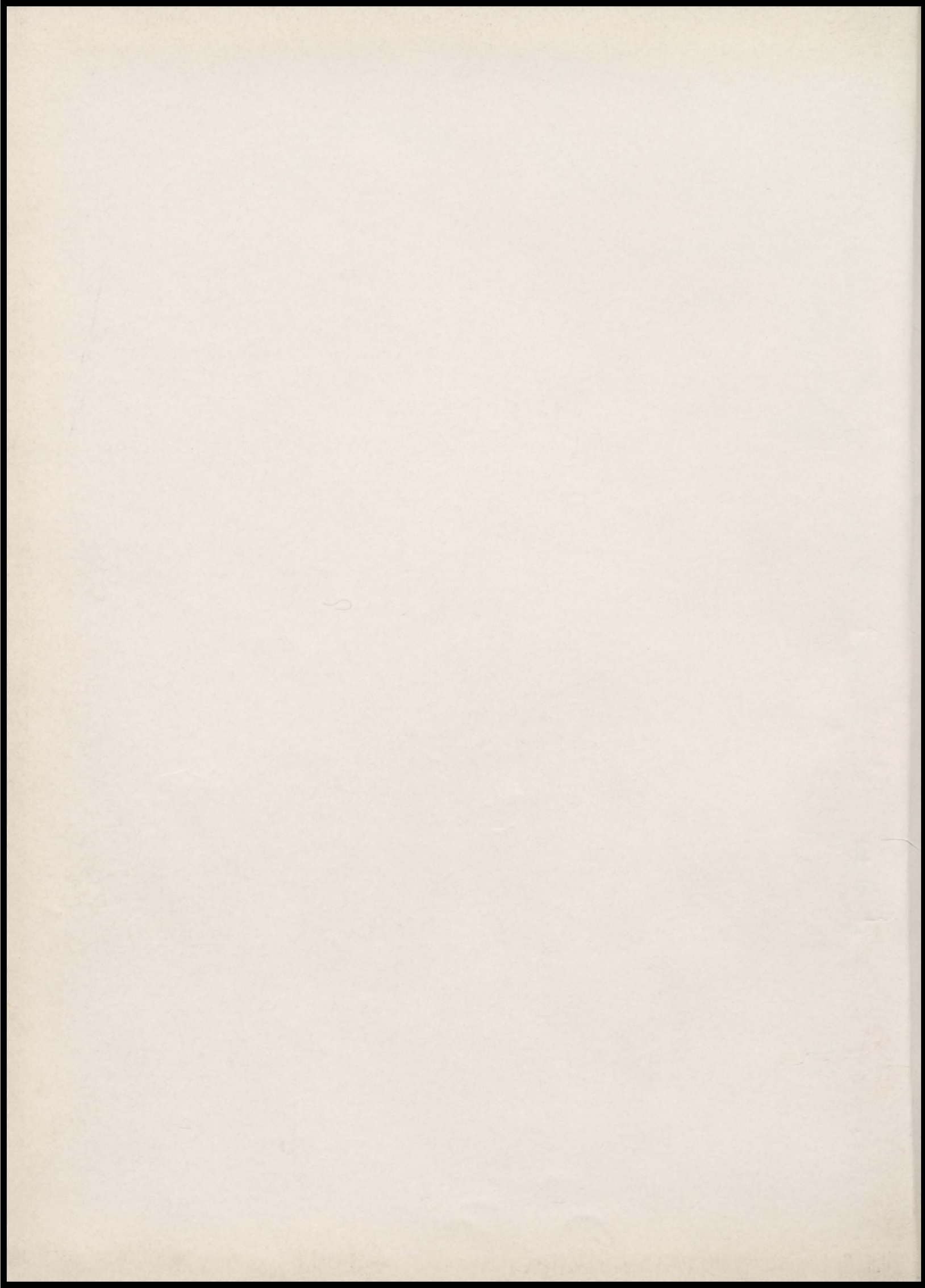

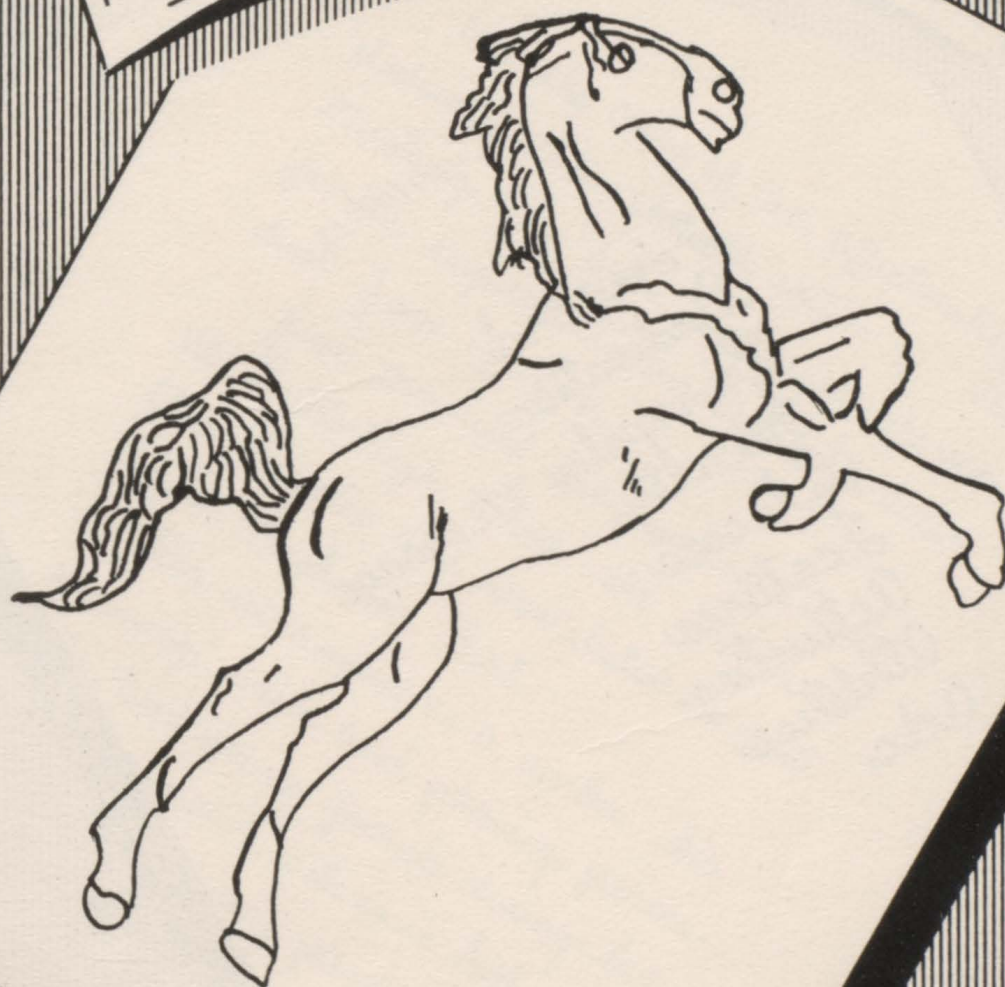

Popular Freshman Girl.

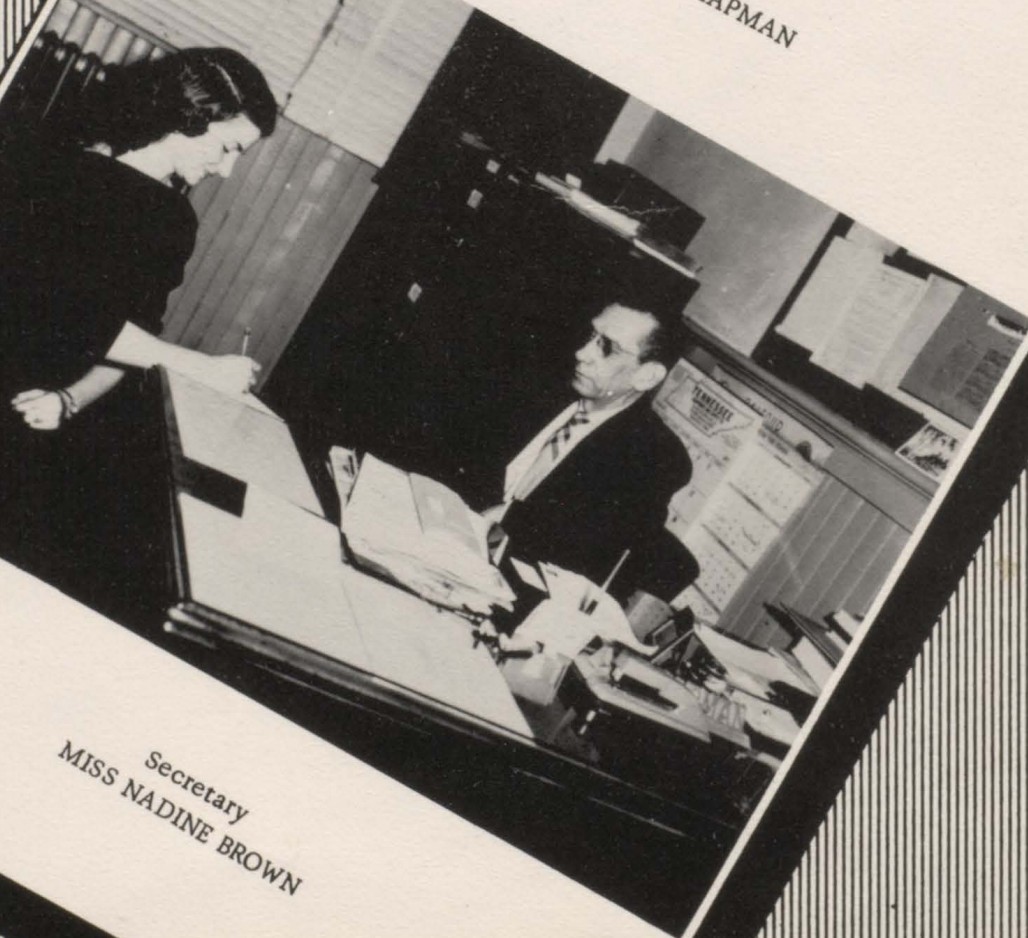
Her willingness as a worker, her
