Pre-K and Kindergarten Registration

On-line registration for Pre-K and Kindergarten in the Lawrence County School System will be available March 23 through April 6 on the lcss.us website. Computers will be available at each elementary school during the Spring Parent/Teacher Conferences on March 23, 2026, 3:00-6:00 for those needing access to a computer or assistance with the on-line registration process.

Kindergarten Enrollment - Children must be 5 years of age on or before August 15, 2026, to be eligible to enroll in kindergarten. To complete the online registration, go to the lcss.us website, click on the K Registration icon, and complete the form. Upon completion, you will receive a message stating you have successfully submitted your form. You will be contacted by the school only if you are requesting for your child to attend an out-of-zone school. If your child is currently attending Pre-K, you will still need to complete the online registration process for Kindergarten. Please plan to attend Kindergarten Sneak-A-Peek held at each elementary school on Tuesday, May 5, at 6:00 p.m. for orientation and to submit the required paperwork. Your child will not be allowed to begin school without required immunizations, health physical (no earlier than August 2025), proof of residency and certified birth certificate (another birth certificate is not required for students currently attending LCSS Pre-K).

Voluntary Pre-K & Integrated Pre-K Enrollment - Children must be 4 years of age on or before August 15, 2026, to enroll in Pre-K. To complete the online registration, go to the lcss.us website, click on the Pre-K Registration icon, and complete the form. Upon completion, you will receive a message stating you have successfully submitted your form. Voluntary Pre-K is income based, so you will need to be able to provide one of the following to document your income: EBT card, 3 check stubs, W-2, unemployment checks, disability form, or other type of income.

Integrated Pre-K classes are inclusive education classes available for preschoolers with and without disabilities and are only offered at Summertown Elementary, David Crockett Elementary, and Leoma Elementary Schools. Tuition for Integrated Pre-K is \$200 per month.

Please have your child's certified birth certificate, shot/physical record, custody papers (if needed) and proof of residency along with the proof of income ready to upload during registration or bring to your appointment. Your child will not be allowed to begin school without required immunizations, health physical (no earlier than August 2025), and certified birth certificate. Those registering a Pre-K student will need to bring required documentation to your appointed day if you did not upload during on-line registration.
