

Lawrence County Schools Pre-K and Kindergarten Registration

Online Pre-K and Kindergarten registration for the Lawrence County School System will be available Monday, March 20 through Friday, April 7, on the Lawrence County School's webpage found at lcss.us. Computers will be available at each of the elementary schools during Parent/Teacher Conferences for those needing access or assistance with the online process. Individual schools will announce the date and times for conferences.

All Pre-K and Kindergarten students entering schools are required by law to meet certain immunization and medical requirements. The following information must be obtained and submitted to your child's school in order for your child to attend any Pre-K or Kindergarten program in the Lawrence County School System.

1. Certified Birth Certificate
2. Immunization Records on Permanent Tennessee *Certificate of Immunization* TCA (49-1765-1769) available from the health department or family physician.
3. Physical Examination (No earlier than August 2022)

Pre-K students must be 4 years of age by August 15, 2023. LCSS Pre-K programs are income-based and preference will be given to economically disadvantaged students first. Those registering a Pre-K student will receive an email or letter by the first of May notifying them of when and where to bring the required paperwork.

Kindergarten students must be 5 years of age by August 15, 2023. A Sneak-a-Peek will be held at each of the elementary schools on Tuesday, May 2 at 6:00 P.M. for Kindergarten student orientation and to submit the required paperwork.

Your child **will not** be allowed to begin school without required immunizations, health physical, and birth certificate.
