- Parent/Teacher conferences in October and March

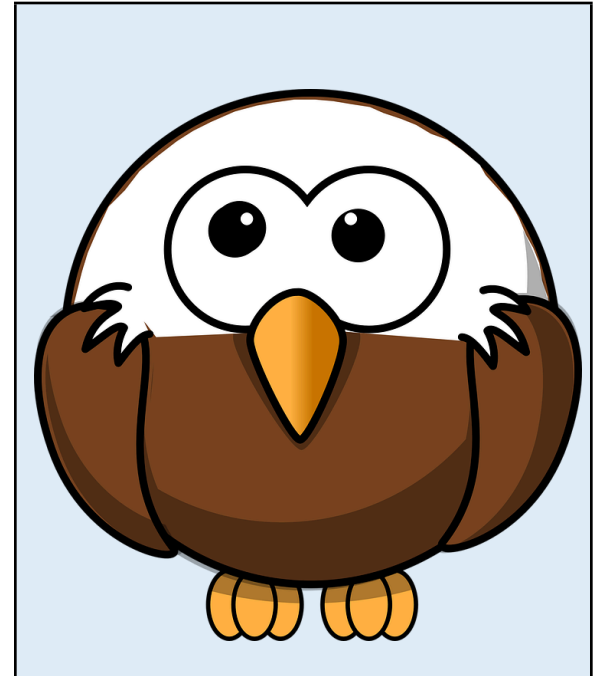




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Our Goals for Student Achievement
